

## **The Nolan James Glover Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship was created in loving memory of Nolan James Glover. Nolan was a graduate of Ecole Secondaire Notre Dame High School in 2014.

Nolan will be fondly remembered as someone who always remained true to himself and genuinely cared about others. Though often identified by his plaid shirts and cowboy boots, Nolan was better known for his personality: one of quick wit, generous humour, and goodwill. One of Nolan's teachers described him as, "a wonderful student and person... respected at school, and liked by staff and students alike." Nolan's easy-going demeanour and social nature were exhibited in the many "chocolate milk walks", he and his friends took before class in the morning, just to have extra time to visit with everyone.

Within the classroom, Nolan often demonstrated leadership by helping others to finish their tasks, and by taking the initiative to develop and enhance his own skills. His mentoring of others was complimented by a patient and encouraging attitude. Two of Nolan's most favoured and successful classes were Mechanics and Electro-technology.

Outside of the classroom, Nolan had interests in motocross, hockey, and even entrepreneurship. Following high school, he had aspirations of a career as a police officer in the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.

This scholarship is meant to recognize those individuals who demonstrate the same intangible qualities that Nolan embodied.
