my Pass

“my Pass” is a self-service website for students to register for diploma exams, retrieve marks and obtain transcripts. All students are required to sign up for a “my Pass” account at www.mypass.alberta.ca

- When applying through **ApplyAlberta** include marks for all relevant courses demanded for admission - even for courses not yet completed. Relevant grade 11 marks should also be used. Your Alberta Student Number (ASN) can easily be found on bottom right corner of your Notre Dame Student ID card.

Studying out of province? For students looking to attend post-secondary schooling outside the province of Alberta, contacting the institution of choice is the best way to get started with your application.

Scholarships, Awards & Bursaries - Tips for Getting Organized

Start researching early	Don't leave items blank	Get organized	Prepare your applications electronically. Cut & paste write ups for future applications
Read eligibility requirements closely	Follow instructions exactly	Make sure the application is legible	Proofread application carefully
Keep a list of what you've applied to	Double check the application	Get your application in early	Send thank you notes if you're successful
