Highlights

- We continue to offer a great educational experience for our students and offer them many different courses,options and support to be successful. Notre Dame outperformed provincial averages in 8 of 10 key measures.
- We are exceptionally proud of our Welcoming, Caring, Safe, Respectful Learning Environment measure of 90.1%. Our staff continues to create the best educational experience for each student at École Secondaire Notre Dame High School.
- Our 3-year and 5-year High School Completion rates were both well above the provincial average. Our 3-year completion rate was 88.6% and 5-year completion rate was 92.4%.
